Following the rich tradition of this Italian Movement, Mirco brings the color, the joy and the finesse that sometimes is lacking in Povera Art. Mirco is the joy of the south, even though he is a man of the north, his colors, his forms and his geometrical combinations bring us closer to meditation, to the hedonistic pleasures that arise under the sun, than to the dark mists that accompany, life in the north of Italy. Mirco Marchelli is a total artist: he is an artist of life, his passions embrace various media, and he excels in all of them.

Mirco, is a quiet man, a man who understands that art and life require time, something that we can see in the slow evolution of his work.
